



### Winter Stableford

Any member wishing to play in the Winter Stableford should put their name on the sheet on the board. A one off charge of £10.00 will be taken from your bar card.

The best 3 scores count with the winner having the lowest combined score.

Members can play both Saturday and Sunday. Tee times must be booked on BRS

### Texas Scrambles and Greensomes

A sheet will go up each month for the winter scrambles and greensomes. A charge of £5.00 per player will be taken from each respective your bar card each time you enter.

Tee times must be booked on BRS and members **must remember to sign in on *Today's Golf on Howdidido* and enter their scores on the computer in the hall. *Howdidido* will not allow scores to be entered**

Guests with a CDH number are permitted to play, but must pay £5.00 at bar on the day of the competition and send an email to [matchsecretary@dumbartongolfclub.co.uk](mailto:matchsecretary@dumbartongolfclub.co.uk) in advance.

All Texas Scrambles and Greensome competitions will take place over the weekend with members choosing to play either Saturday or Sunday (or both – please indicate if you intend to on the sheet).

### Winter Competition Rules

#### Handicaps are set by WHS

Winter mats are in play from the fairway and fringe. No mats are allowed to be used in the rough. All bunkers are Ground Under Repair. The reference point is the nearest point of relief. After this you are permitted 1 club length to drop – no nearer the hole.

**Greensome** – Both players tee off on each hole. They select their preferred drive and play alternate shot from this point.

**Canadian Greensome**- Both players tee off on each hole. They both play their own ball again, before choosing best ball then alternate shot.

**Russian Stableford** – Both players tee off. They play their partners ball for the second shot. They select their preferred approach and play alternate shot from this point.



**4-person Texas Scramble** – Minimum 4 drives for each player. If an approach from the rough is selected all players, that didn't play the approach, must drop their ball prior to playing their approach. Handicap allowance is 25%/20%/15%/10% course handicap from lowest to highest (computer will calculate this).

**2-person Texas Scramble** – Minimum 7 drives for each player. If an approach from the rough is selected the player that didn't play the approach must drop their ball prior to playing their approach. Handicap allowance is 35%/15% course handicap (Low/High).
